## SEPTEMBER 13, 2026

### **BYU Jerusalem Center, Mount of Olives, Gethsemane**

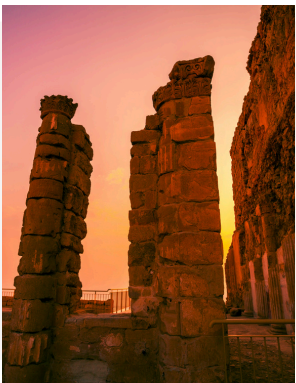

## SEPTEMBER 21, 2026

### Transfer to Petra, Visit Madaba & Mount Nebo

Visiting Madaba and Mount Nebo provides a rich historical and spiritual experience. In Madaba, the 6th-century Mosaic Map showcases ancient Jerusalem and reflects the town's Byzantine and Islamic heritage. Then, at Mount Nebo, the biblical site where Moses viewed the Promised Land, visitors can enjoy stunning views of the Jordan Valley, Dead Sea, and Jerusalem. The mountain's serene atmosphere and religious significance create a profoundly moving experience.

## SEPTEMBER 22, 2026

### Explore Petra

Exploring Petra, the Red Rose City, reveals a hidden world of ancient wonders. The journey through the Siq leads to the breathtaking Treasury carved into rose-colored cliffs, creating a living history experience. Deeper exploration uncovers remarkable ruins like the Roman-style theater, Royal Tombs, and a monastery with panoramic views, showcasing the beauty and scale of this once-thriving Nabatean city.
