OCTOBER 21, 2024

Take care to have all your paperwork prepared for travel weeks before you travel, i.e. having a passport valid for 6-months after the last day of your tour. Check your pre-travel information sent to your email. Reminder, travel insurance provides protection for your investment in this trip.



OCTOBER 22, 2024

Today we visit: Mound City, home of the Hopewell Culture National Historical Park in Chillicothe. Northfork Earthworks are in the Hopewell Mound Group and display both above ground and below the ritual landscape of the mounds. In addition we'll visit Seip Mound, a famous effigy mound and Fort Hill. Here you'll see an ancient hilltop fortress with defense earthworks similar to those described in the Book of Mormon.



OCTOBER 23, 2024

Today we visit the Johnson Humrickhouse House Museum, The Great Circle and Great Octagon. The Johnson Humrick house holds the amazing HOLY Stones that have Block Hebrew engravings of the Ten Commandments. Not far away is are the mounds of the Great Circle and Great Octagon which are the remains of an ancient 4 square mile ceremonial complex



OCTOBER 24, 2024

Today we visit the mysterious Serpent Mound atop a sacred plateau, Fort Ancient, another hill-top fortress with miles of embankments and trenches, and the impressive Miamisburg Adena Mound.



OCTOBER 25, 2024

Today we visit the Shrum Mound, Ohio History Center, Enon Mound and Indian Mound Reserve. Shrum Mound is a Native American burial mound created around 2000 years ago by the Adena culture. In the Ohio History Center, you'll discover some of the vast earthworks that American Indian people built 2,000 years ago. The Enon mound is an Adena mound and is over an acre in circumference and 40 feet high.



OCTOBER 26, 2024
